

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

To ensure you're fully prepared for your European vacation, please refer to the information below and consult your travel advisor with any questions.

NEW ETIAS REQUIREMENT

In accordance with the European Travel Information and Authorization System (ETIAS), an <u>ETIAS waiver</u> will be required for U.S. passport holders traveling to Europe for up to 90 days within a 180-day period. This requirement is expected to become effective in May 2025 at the earliest. Refer to the <u>ETIAS</u> website for updates.

DOCUMENTATION

Proper documentation is your responsibility. For travel to European countries, your passport must be valid for up to **6 months** after your return. Contact your advisor or the consulates of the countries you're visiting for the most current requirements. We strongly recommend carrying a color copy of your passport's picture page on your person; however, if traveling between countries, carry your actual passport. If you've been immunized for COVID-19, we suggest bringing your vaccine card.

HEALTH & SAFETY

We strongly recommend that you visit the <u>U.S. Department of State</u> and <u>Center for Disease Control and</u> <u>Prevention</u> websites for important information on foreign travel, as well as our Health & Safety Tips.

BAGGAGE

The standard carry-on size for European carriers is slightly smaller than U.S. domestic flights, measuring 21.7 by 15.7 by 9 inches. Please check your <u>air carrier's website</u> to ensure that your baggage size and weight meet their requirements.

ELECTRONICS

The official voltage for Europe, the UK, and Ireland is 230, whereas most U.S. outlets are 110V. If your appliances don't use this voltage, you'll need to purchase an outlet converter adaptable for 2 round-pronged or 3 flat rectangle-pronged (UK and Ireland) outlets.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEAL PLANS

In general, rooms are smaller than in the Americas, and washcloths and toiletries are often not provided. Many hotels offer meal plans such as:

All-inclusive – Includes all meals, select drinks, daily activities, and nightly entertainment. Such plans may also be referred to as *Endless Privileges*[®] or *Unlimited-Luxury*[®].

Full-board - Includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Half-board – Includes breakfast and lunch.

DINING OUT

Tipping in restaurants is appreciated, but often not expected. When tipping is common, 5% is normal and 10% is considered generous. Service is generally less hurried than in the Americas.



FINAL WORDS OF WISDOM

Travel light, wear comfortable shoes, and ensure your luggage has sturdy wheels to withstand the steps and cobbled streets of Europe. Finally, be prepared to pay a small fee for the use of public restrooms!

SPAIN 7-DAY CURATED ITINERARY

Day 1 – Arrival in Madrid

Begin your exploration of Spain in its capital, the vibrant city of Madrid. Get to know its avenues, architecture, and attractions from a double-decker bus, hopping off to discover any sights that catch your fancy. For your first evening, embrace the local heritage with a flamenco show featuring another Spanish must: delectable, small-bite tapas.

Discover the cultural scene next, as you visit the Picasso Museum, Museum of Chocolate, and the Banksy Museum. Between exhibits, stop for lunch at the Palau de la Música Catalana, a shining example of Art Nouveau.

Day 5 - Montserrat & Barcelona

Travel beyond Barcelona's borders to Montserrat, a picturesque mountain range home to the peaceful Santa Maria Monastery. Later, see Antoni Gaudí's unfinished masterpiece, La Sagrada Familia, on a guided skip-the-line tour. End your day learning to make paella, one of Spain's signature dishes, with your own market-sourced ingredients. Sample your recipe for yourself during a family-style dinner complete with tapas and sangria.

Day 6 – Barcelona

Today, you'll visit one of Gaudi's most popular works, the colorful Park Güell, a 17-hectare modernist wonderland in the midst of the city. From there, enjoy a leisurely self-guided walking tour for a deep dive into Catalonia's trademark art style, checking Casa Vicens, Casa Mila, Casa Amatller, Casa Batlló, and Casa Lleó Morera off your list.

Day 7 – Departure from Barcelona

Take one last stroll around Barcelona, browsing the myriad shops of Las Ramblas, the city's most famous boulevard, for mementos.






BARCELONA

Cosmopolitan, chic, and more than a little Gaudí, the capital of Catalonia is a unique city that is unabashedly proud to be itself. Catalan Spanish flows smoothly from lips with a distinctive accent, as tapas, paellas, *jamon iberico*, regional fish, sausage, olives, and wine are raised up to them.

Eyes, on the other hand, can't help but be lifted to the skies, following the lines of Modernist master Antoni Gaudí's architectural designs, from Casa Mila to the still-under-construction La Sagrada Familia and UNESCO World Heritage works such as the fantastically bizarre Park Güell.

Art Nouveau and Modernism aren't the only movements to sweep through the streets of Barcelona. Roman, Romanesque, and Gothic designs bring an old-world feel to districts like tree-lined l'Eixample and to world-famous Las Ramblas. This wide boulevard guides visitors to the entrance of historic Barrio Gótico—the original city site founded by Romans, featuring medieval palaces, gourmet restaurants, and jazz venues—and leads to the Port Vell Harbor, a popular cruise port with waterfront eateries and easy access to the golden beach of Barceloneta.


MADRID

Effusions of plant life bring vibrancy to squares such as La Plaza del Potro, only minutes from the Alcazar fortress and medieval Jewish Quarter.

Ride a boat to a snorkeling site, don a supplied face mask, snorkel, and neoprene suit, and waft through the waters with a guide to see a wide array of fish. Ideal for beginners and experienced snorkelers. Choose from a morning or afternoon experience.

Departs From Tenerife Teide Masca Grand Tour

Tour the most characteristic places in northern Tenerife from an air-conditioned bus, beginning with Teide National Park, where you can opt for a cable car ride to the top. Upon descent, see the Millennial Dragon Tree, Garachico port and its artististic center, the Masca ravine and historic hamlet, and pass Santiago del Teide. Be sure to try real Canarian cuisine in the Ycoden Daute Isora area.

Jeep Safari Teide Masca

From your hotel or nearby point, embark on a four-wheel drive caravan tour (maximum of 8 per vehicle) atop the slopes of the inactive Pico Viejo volcano, through Masca village, and Teide National Park. Begin in Playa de las Américas, make your way to the village of Vilaflor, then a restaurant in Tamaimo where you can purchase a Canary Islands set lunch.

Royal Delfin Catamaran Tour

This 4.5-hour catamaran tour searching for whales departs from Puerto Colon and sails along the southwestern coast, from Costa Adeje to the majestic cliffs of Acantilados de Los Gigantes. Stop at the Bay of Masca with its splendid views of the cliffs to take a dip and enjoy lunch. Drinks are included throughout the excursion.

VIP Tour: Anaga & La Laguna

Discover two fascinating sides of Tenerife from the comfort of an air-conditioned four-wheel drive minivan with seven passengers or less with your own water and sunscreen. Head to UNESCO-listed city San Cristóbal de La Laguna, the ancient forest and 7 - 9 million year-old volcanic formation of Anaga, La Teresitas Beach, then Tagana for an included lunch of real Canary Island cuisine. Not for children under 3.

La Gomera Jeep Tour

Explore one of the world's most unique islands on a small group Jeep safari. From your pick-up point, you'll be transferred to a ferry that will take you to San Sebastián de La Gomera to join a small caravan of Jeeps. Together, travel to the island's most fascinating features for exploration including Garajonay National Park. *Includes lunch*.

Departs From Tenerife Peter Pan 3-Hour Cruise

In an authentic Portuguese gulet of the last century, relive the emotions of ancient sailing with stories of pirates on this fun family cruise. Peter Pan features an open bar, lounge for about fifteen, and an upper deck. See where pilot whales and dolphins congregate, then anchor in the marine reserve of La Caleta or Palm-Mar for a swim and included lunch.

Shogun 5-Hour Boat Cruise

On this cruise boat with two levels and an open bar, enjoy the unique opportunity to view many species of cetaceans like pilot whales and bottlenose dolphins, along with other migratory species such as fin whales and sperm whales. Afterward, anchor in the Bay of Masca to admire the impressive cliffs of Los Gigantes and enjoy a swim and hearty lunch.

Teide National Park & Cable Car

The highlight? Being sky-high on Spain's highest peak, over 7,775 feet above sea level. But first, your air-conditioned bus drives through Canarian pine forests and traditional villages to an optional cable car (tickets must be purchased at time of tour booking; not permitted for people pregnant, with heart problems, or under 3). Cross an enormous caldera and see the Roques de García formations before returning.


Tenerife Island & Masca

Head to Villa de Candelaria to visit its basilica with the Virgin of Candelaria, the patron saint of the Canary Islands. Continue to La Laguna, a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Stroll through the artistic Old Town of Villa de La Orotava, and then on to Garachico. Visit Teno Rural Park to see the Hamlet of Masca, one of Tenerife's most beautiful landscapes.

Santa Cruz, La Laguna & Taganana

In this reduced mobility-friendly tour, start from modern capital and maritime hub Santa Cruz de Tenerife and on to La Laguna, Tenerife's first conquest-founded city, to walk its streets. On an air-conditioned bus, ride to Anaga Rural Park, a Biosphere Natural Reserve with a Tertiary Era laurel forest, then ocean-and-cliff hamlet Taganana for free time and lunch. End with a detour to Las Teresitas beach.
