

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

To ensure you're fully prepared for your European vacation, please refer to the information below and consult your travel advisor with any questions.

NEW ETIAS REQUIREMENT

In accordance with the European Travel Information and Authorization System (ETIAS), an <u>ETIAS waiver</u> will be required for U.S. passport holders traveling to Europe for up to 90 days within a 180-day period. This requirement is expected to become effective in May 2025 at the earliest. Refer to the <u>ETIAS</u> website for updates.

DOCUMENTATION

Proper documentation is your responsibility. For travel to European countries, your passport must be valid for up to **6 months** after your return. Contact your advisor or the consulates of the countries you're visiting for the most current requirements. We strongly recommend carrying a color copy of your passport's picture page on your person; however, if traveling between countries, carry your actual passport. If you've been immunized for COVID-19, we suggest bringing your vaccine card.

HEALTH & SAFETY

We strongly recommend that you visit the <u>U.S. Department of State</u> and <u>Center for Disease Control and</u> <u>Prevention</u> websites for important information on foreign travel, as well as our Health & Safety Tips.

BAGGAGE

The standard carry-on size for European carriers is slightly smaller than U.S. domestic flights, measuring 21.7 by 15.7 by 9 inches. Please check your <u>air carrier's website</u> to ensure that your baggage size and weight meet their requirements.

ELECTRONICS

The official voltage for Europe, the UK, and Ireland is 230, whereas most U.S. outlets are 110V. If your appliances don't use this voltage, you'll need to purchase an outlet converter adaptable for 2 round-pronged or 3 flat rectangle-pronged (UK and Ireland) outlets.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEAL PLANS

In general, rooms are smaller than in the Americas, and washcloths and toiletries are often not provided. Many hotels offer meal plans such as:

All-inclusive – Includes all meals, select drinks, daily activities, and nightly entertainment. Such plans may also be referred to as *Endless Privileges*[®] or *Unlimited-Luxury*[®].

Full-board - Includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Half-board – Includes breakfast and lunch.

DINING OUT

Tipping in restaurants is appreciated, but often not expected. When tipping is common, 5% is normal and 10% is considered generous. Service is generally less hurried than in the Americas.



FINAL WORDS OF WISDOM

Travel light, wear comfortable shoes, and ensure your luggage has sturdy wheels to withstand the steps and cobbled streets of Europe. Finally, be prepared to pay a small fee for the use of public restrooms!

Regardless of the European destination, find yourself swept up in the romance of a fairy tale—a story still being written.












ITALY La Dolce Vita

rome tours

Legends of Rome

Starting from Piazza Bocca della Verità, this guided Velabro walking tour visits places that marked the creation of Rome. This small part of the city offers beauty, history, and myth, lived in the shadow of the renowned Bocca della Verità for many years.

The Jewish Ghetto

Walk from the Campidoglio, Theater of Marcello, into the Jewish Ghetto to admire Rome's largest synagogue. Stroll through Campo di'Fiori Square with its daily markets, then hop over the oldest bridge in Rome to Tiber Island, and up to the Trastevere district where the tour culminates at Piazza Santa Maria Square.

Rome at Sunset

On this walk around the Eternal City at sunset, cross the Jewish Ghetto, one of Rome's most beautiful neighborhoods, pass the Turtle Fountain in Piazza Mattei, and then head to Piazza Della Rotonda to see the lit view of the Pantheon. Throw a coin into the Trevi Fountain and continue to Piazza di Spagna at the bottom of the Spanish Steps. Finish with a gelato!

Day Tour of Venice

Join a day trip to Venice, just a few hours by train from Rome. Upon arrival, the waterbus gives you a first glimpse of Venice's breathtaking architecture, historical buildings, churches, docks, and gondolas. Walk to St. Mark's Square and admire the façade of St. Mark's Basilica. Spend free time shopping, dining, sightseeing, or taking a gondola ride.

Capri Island

Leave early on a private bus to Naples to board the ferry to Capri Island. Head to the famous Piazzetta and enjoy lunch at a restaurant with panoramic views. Then visit the spectacular Blue Grotto, once the personal swimming hole of Emperor Tiberius, and admire the incredible illuminating inside view. Depart in the late afternoon back to Rome.

Fountains, Squares & Tastings

Enjoy a morning walking tour of Rome and see its most symbolic sights, including the Spanish Steps, dominated by the Church of Trinità dei Monti, the famous Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and Piazza Navona, built on the ruins of the Stadium of Domitian, adorned by Bernini's Fountain of Four Rivers. During the tour, enjoy tastings of local products.

Ancient Rome

Visit the massive Colosseum, built in only 8 years from 72 to 80 AD to seat 70,000 spectators for gladiatorial matches. Then on to the Roman Forum—center of Rome during the Monarchy. Even after 20 centuries, walk on the same cobblestones leading to Capitol Hill, and then to Venice Square.

The Romans Once Upon a Time

Admire artistic treasures at the Museo Nazionale Romano, the Palazzo Massimo, and Terme di Diocleziano. Stroll ihrough woods once belonging to the Thermal Baths of Diocletian and a huge courtyard restored by Michelangelo. See the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angelia with its planetary sundial built by XVII-century astronomers.

Vatican Museums & St. Peter's

Skip the line on this small-group tour of the Vatican Museums. View the world's largest private art collection. Stroll through Raphael's rooms adorned with paintings by Raphael and his pupils. Reach the Sistine Chapel and admire Michelangelo's astounding frescoes. End at St. Peter's Square to see St. Peter's Basilica.

Ancient Rome & The Jewish Ghetto

On this morning tour, visit Trastevere and the old Jewish ghetto. Start from Piazza Trilussa in Trastevere, visit St. Mary's Basilica, and arrive at Tiberine Island. Cross the river to a huge complex called Portico d'Ottavia in the old Jewish ghetto. See Bernini's beautiful Turtle Fountain and the Sant'Andrea della Valle church. End at Giordano Bruno's Square.

Rome Off the Beaten Track

On this tour, you'll walk underground three times through ruins and columns, enter a 2000-year-old market, and cross Rome's oldest bridge to Tiber Island. Visit the underground house of Santa Cecilia, featuring ancient mosaics, mysterious inscriptions, and a lavishly ornated crypt, as well as the church of San Crisogono.

Morning Cooking Lesson

Starting in a food market near the Vatican, you'll be introduced to the ingredients of traditional Italian specialties. Continue the experience by preparing your own Italian dishes and homemade pasta. Taste your creations with some of the Lazio region's best wines.

Tasting of Roman Flavors

Enjoy an evening walking tour of Rome including the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain, and the Pantheon. The tour ends at Piazza Navona, built on the ruins of the Stadium of Domitian, adorned by Bernini's Fountain of Four Rivers. Enjoy a cappuccino or espresso, and chocolate freshly prepared in a traditional sweet shop.

Vatican Museums by Night

Skip the line on this small-group evening tour of the Vatican Museums. Admire paintings by Raphael and his pupils. Visit the Sistine Chapel—the Holy Chapel of the Pope—to appreciate Michelangelo's amazing frescoes including *The Creation of the World* and *The Last Judgment*, and other famous works by Perugino, Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, and more.

Vatican, St. Peter's & Colosseum

Admire the massive Colosseum, built in only 8 years from 72 to 80 AD. Continue to the Roman Forum—the political, commercial, social, and religious center of Rome during the Monarchy. Reach Venice Square to admire the imposing monumental complex dedicated to Italy's first King. Enjoy lunch and then visit the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's.


Fountains, Squares & Vatican

This full-day tour starts at the Spanish Steps and continues to the Trevi Fountain and the Pantheon. After lunch, visit the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel to admire Michelangelo's famous masterpieces. Continue to St. Peter's Basilica to see its aweinspiring architecture, mosaics, and masterpieces. End at Piazza Navona, adorned by Bernini's Fountain.

Countryside Food & Wine Tasting

Tour the heart of the Roman countryside, riding along the Via Appia Antica to admire the historical villages including Castel Gandolfo, the Pope's summer residence. Stop for a tasting of four wines. Continue to Lake Albano to taste the famous *porchetta* with local wine. Continue to Nemi, home to the Museum of Roman Ships and a magical lake.







ROME 5-DAY CURATED ITINERARY

Day 1 – Arrival

After settling in, enjoy a day of discovery at your own pace on a hop-on, hop-off bus tour. Stroll through Piazza Navona, home to several famous fountains, including Bernini's *Fountain of the Four Rivers*. In the evening, head to the trendy Trastevere district to enjoy live street music and a delicious Italian dinner.

Day 2 - Icons of Rome

Experience Rome's headline acts on this full-day tour with skip-the-line access. With an expert guide, head inside the hallowed Vatican Museums through a reserved entrance. Witness their artistic treasures, including Michelangelo's extraordinary frescos in the Sistine Chapel. Continue to St. Peter's Basilica before stopping for lunch. Afterward, tour the stunning Colosseum and the Roman Forum's evocative ruins.

Day 3 - Roman Countryside

With your private driver, head to the wooded hills of Castelli Romani. This 5-hour tour stops at Antico Casale, where you'll meet the winemaker and tour the vineyard and cellars. Later, learn how to make traditional Italian pizza from a professional chef, and enjoy your homemade meal.

Day 4 – Cultural Classics

Focusing on the most exciting gourmet haunts in Trastevere and the Jewish Ghetto, join a small group walking tour that includes Campo de' Fiori's famous market. Sample Italian classics such as pasta, fried artichokes, and gelato. Later, tour the Borghese Gallery, Rome's most exclusive art museum.

Day 5 – Departure

Enjoy breakfast at a Roman café and take a final stroll from the Spanish Steps to the Trevi Fountain. Toss in a coin to ensure your return to the Eternal City. *Arrivederci*—until next time!








FLORENCE

FLORENCE TOURS

Best of Florence Walking Tour

Begin at one of the most historic piazzas in Florence, Piazza della Repubblica, to arrive at Loggia del Mercato Nuovo for a good luck rub of the *Porcellino* statue. Learn about this and other local legends with your guide, who will then take you to Ponte Vecchio, Accademia dei Gergofili, Uffuzi Square, Piazza della Signoria, and Piazza San Giovanni, where you'll end beneath the shadow of the cathedral.

Best of Florence & Accademia Gallery

Florence, the city of the Renaissance, offers amazing architectural wonders and works of art. See the highlights of the city described above in the Best of Florence walking tour. Also, enjoy a guided visit to the famous Accademia Gallery to admire Michelangelo's masterpieces, including the original *David, and I Prigioni*.

Best of Florence & Uffizi Gallery

See the highlights of the city described above in the Best of Florence walking tour, but also visit the famous Uffizi Gallery. The museum is huge, yet the organized itinerary allows you to admire all the main masterpieces and understand the development of Italian art during the centuries, starting with Giotto and Masaccio.

Siena, San Gimignano & Chianti with Wine Tasting

Cross the Chianti hills to the hilltop walls of Monteriggioni and stately architecture of Siena. Refresh yourself with San Gimignano's famous white wine, then drink in views of Vernaccia, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Do some sightseeing on your own along its narrow streets, reconvene over included gelato, then melt back into the postcard-perfect landscape of Chianti.

Half-Day Pisa Tour

Journey through the countryside in a Mercedes to walk around Piazza dei Miracoli, where the city's symbol has stood for 840 years ... alongside other historic buildings like the cathedral and Monumental Graveyard, which was partially destroyed during WWII. Another popular stop is Piazza dei Cavalieri's Muda Tower, where Dante's Count Ugolino della Gherardesca and his family were immured.

Pisa & The Leaning Tower

Visit this symbolic city and its famous leaning tower on this halfday guided tour. Your guide will share stories of Pisa as you tour the monuments and the precious interiors of the Cathedral, a masterpiece of Romanesque art.

Full-Day Pisa and Lucca Tour

Arrive in Pisa to tour the Piazza dei Miracoli and admire the Baptistery, Monumental Cemetery, the Leaning Tower, and the Cathedral. After free time for exploration, head to Lucca, famous for its medieval walls. In the town center, see the Anfiteatro Square, Guinigi Tower, and San Martino Cathedral. End with a Bucelalto cake tasting.

Pisa, Siena & San Gimignano

Wander a UNESCO World Heritage Site, medieval towns, and unforgettable urban spaces in this all-day Tuscan tour. You'll see artistic masterpieces by Ambrogio Lorenzetti and architectural ones like the Collegiata. Experience history through the still-standing 13 towers of San Gimignano, the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo of Siena, Piazza dei Miracoli, and more.

Chianti Colors and Flavors Tour

Fine wine and rolling hills lure visitors away from the city to enjoy relaxing afternoons in the Tuscan countryside. Begin with snacks at a rustic wine estate with home-produced olive oil, then visit Greve, the best-known Chianti-producing village. Walk its alleys and medieval square, visit artisan shops, then finish with another wine tasting with local products and among the olive trees of the estate.

Montalcino, Pienza & Montepulciano

Explore three beautiful towns on this full-day tour, starting with a tasting in Montalcino, land of Brunello wine. Next, stop at Pienza, offering extraordinary views from its hill. Enjoy a Pecorino cheese tasting and explore the small town at your leisure. Lastly, enjoy a wine tasting at Vino Nobile vineyards in Montepulciano.

Pastamania Class

Learn the secrets of making homemade pasta like ravioli and tagliatelle in the center of Florence. Taste your prepared pasta with three different sauces, along with organic Tuscan wine. Participants will receive pasta-making instructions to take home.

World War II History Tour

Explore Florence on a private tour with a World War II history expert. Walk through the areas that were most damaged by the war and learn about Italy's involvement and the true story of Benito Mussolini and fascism in Italy. See the Ponte Vecchio, the Pitti Palace, and more at your own pace.

Cortona & Montepulciano

On this private tour with an expert driver, visit Cortona , a town that sits high above sea level and offers spectacular valley and lake views. Just outside the city, visit the Hermitage of San Francesco, Le Celle. Next, tour ancient underground cellars in the medieval city of Montepulciano. Enjoy five wine tastings.

Tuscany on Horseback

Explore the countryside on horseback, and enjoy the sights, sounds, and smells of the Chianti region as you ride through lush vineyards, native woods, olive groves, and rolling hills. Next, visit the medieval town of San Gimignano, then enjoy a Tuscan lunch and guided Chianti wine tasting. *No horseback riding experience required.*

Pisa & Lucca

Embark on this private 8-hour tour of Pisa and Lucca. Pisa, known for its architectural wonders, is home to some of the oldest yet best preserved buildings in the region, like its Leaning Tower. Meanwhile, in Lucca, Giacomo Puccini's hometown, take a stroll on the streets and indulge in a traditional lunch at a trattoria.

Palazzo Pitti & Boboli Gardens

Enjoy the artistry in the Palatine Gallery, Silver Museum, Museum of Modern Art, Costume Gallery, Porcelain Museum, and Museum of Carriages. FLORENCE 5-DAY CURATED ITINERARY

Day 1 – Arrival

After checking into your hotel, stroll through Piazza della Signoria, Florence's main square. Shop for fine jewelry and leather goods in the boutiques surrounding Ponte Vecchio, the only bridge in the city spared from destruction during World War II. In the evening, enjoy a traditional dinner such as Florentine steak (*bistecca alla Fiorentina*).

Day 2 - Art of the Renaissance

View *David* and other masterpieces by Michelangelo, along with Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, and Giambologna, at the Academia Museum. Enjoy skip-theline access and narration from an expert guide. Later, explore the Museum of Musical Instruments and continue with a guided tour of the historic city center. Finally, visit the Uffizi Gallery to view more artistic masterpieces from the Italian greats.

Day 3 - Duomo and Maggio Musicale

Discover the heart of Florence and learn the history of the Duomo complex. The museum houses the world's largest collection of Florentine sculptures. Admire the stunning Baptistry of San Giovanni and the church of Santa Maria del Fiore, known for its 17-foot, bronze East Door. After dinner, catch a show at the Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino.

Day 4 – Day Trip to Chianti

Venture outside the city for an afternoon in the Tuscan countryside. Explore the Chianti wine region, stopping in Greve, one of its most famous vinous villages. Among the olive trees, gentle hills, and vineyards, sample local wines made sweeter by the views.

Day 5 – Departure

Visit the Piazzale Michelangelo for a stunning panorama of Florence—the perfect vantage point for taking your last photos of this glorious city. Pick up some reasonably priced Italian leather luggage to carry all your fabulous new treasures home.







TUSCANY

Tall cypresses stand guard just outside the cities of Tuscany, while red-roofed farmhouses and fields of sunflowers add pops of joyful color. SICILY

The island that decorates the toe of "the boot" may have been a part of Italy since 1860, but this former kingdom's roots go far deeper, back to the tribes that settled the volcanic lands of Sicily in 8000 BCE. Rich culture, an independent spirit, and a stirring regional identity lend character to the biggest island in the Mediterranean.

In popular cities such as Taormina, history is as inescapable as glorious sea views or the shadow cast by the majestic Mount Etna, the biggest active volcano in Europe. Although its main attractions include the 10th century Arabic Covaja Palace, 13th century cathedral, and 17th century Baroque Fountain, Church of St. Joseph, and Saracen Castle, the most impressive archeological site is perhaps the Greek Theater, Sicily's center of ancient Greek civilization. A love of the arts, well-known film festival, and lovely beaches round out the visual splendor this city has to offer.

For large-scale design, Palermo on the island's northwestern coast holds its own. Romanesque, Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque architecture showcase the best of their eras around the Piazza Pretoria's winding streets, and modern art provides a pleasant pop of additional culture in the galleries and museums.







SICILY 5-DAY CURATED ITINERARY

Day 1 – Arrival in Palermo

Start with a stroll through Centro Storico, the heart of Palermo and home to many famous landmarks, restaurants, and bars. Grab a bite, or head back to the hotel for a rest and then to the lively Kalsa district for dinner, one of the four ancient quarters of Sicily. Walk through its historic alleyways and shop for handmade ceramics, woodwork, and textiles.

Day 2 – Historical Palermo

Today, take in the major sights of Palermo, starting from Quattro Canti (*Piazza Vigliena*), a Baroque square and the center of Sicily's historic quarter. Visit the Cathedral and Palazzo dei Normanni, also called the Royal Palace and Palace of the Romans, and considered one of Sicily's most extraordinary buildings. Enjoy the view from the highest point of the ancient city center.

Day 3 – Catania

Enjoy a scenic 2.5-hour drive—by rental car or private service—to Catania, a beautiful historical city and the perfect home base for exploring the coast. Discover Mt. Etna, at whose feet the city is perched, the famous Roman Theatre, Piazza del Duomo—a favorite for its smiling *Fountain of Elephants*—and the Cathedral of Sant'Agata, destroyed and painstakingly rebuilt several times across history.

Day 4 – Day Trip to Taormina

Venture out to the chic resort town of Taormina, a 1-hour drive from Catania and one of the most beautiful places in Sicily. Take in the breathtaking views over the coastline, and visit the ancient theater still in use today. Later, grab some photos at the Villa Comunale overlook before recharging with an antipasto sampler in Corso Umberto, Taormina's lively main street. Return to Catania, exploring any final must-see sights.

Day 5 – Departure from Catania

Sip one last espresso—best with *brioche con granita*—then head to Villa Bellini, one of Italy's most exquisite public gardens, for gorgeous hilltop views that make for a perfect farewell vista. Say a fond goodbye to Sicily as you continue on to the airport and your flight home.
